

Above Ground Pool Delivery and Installation Prices 2017

After you purchase your pool, you will receive a FREE copy of the Swimming Pool Contractors Blue Pages. It will give you phone numbers and advertisements for Installers, Electricians, Delivery Services, Sand and Stone Dust, Patio Blocks, Excavating and Ground Leveling. Feel free to hire anyone there, anyone from the Yellow Pages, or anyone else that you wish. It will have no effect on your warranty as long as they simply follow the manufacturer's instructions. **We have two binders full of customer reviews of many contractors.** Take a look to see what they say. If you purchase a pool from us, we will invite you to review your contractors too.

We have also hired some of the contractors from the Blue Pages ourselves to do work in our Pool Park. The Pool Park Map notes who built what, so you can inspect their workmanship. The fact that we hired someone does not mean that we think you should hire him, and the fact that we did not hire someone does not mean that you should not hire him. We cannot accept any liability for whom you hire or when they actually install your pool.

Just as a reference, we've included some typical local market prices and schedules so you can get some idea of what you are going to be spending and when. If the prices you are quoted seem high, or the wait seems long, shop around some more or try installing yourself. Round pools are easier than oval, and most of the work is in leveling the ground. If you do plan to install yourself, consider hiring out the ground leveling instead of doing it by hand. All of the professionals level by machine, and many of them use contractors who are on the Ground Leveling List. Fuel surcharges expected as gas gets over \$4.00/gallon.

*Note: In 2000, it did not stop raining until May 20th and the ground did not ever dry out properly—then it rained all July and August, too! In 2001, there were some areas that experienced major winter damage. Installers that were willing to quote and later do repairs, eventually got to be months behind. Installers who refused repairs and just did new pools were relatively quick.
